**Procedural Order No. 4**

The Tribunal has considered the request by the United Republic of Tanzania (“GOT”), consented to by Standard Chartered Bank (“SCB”), for a two-week extension of time to file its Memorial on Jurisdiction with witness testimony and documents. The Tribunal grants GOT’s request and hereby enters Procedural Order No. 4, modifying the schedule, as set forth in the 23 November 2011 Minutes of the First Session of the Tribunal, and SCB’s letter of 8 December 2011, as follows:

1. The Respondent will file its Memorial on Jurisdiction with witness testimony and documents on 23 June 2001, rather than 9 June 2011;
2. The Claimant will file its Counter-Memorial on Jurisdiction with witness testimony and documents on 4 August 2011, rather than 21 July 2011;
3. The Respondent will file its Reply Memorial on Jurisdiction with reply testimony and documents on 26 September 2011, rather than 19 September 2011;
4. The Claimant will file its Rejoinder on Jurisdiction with witness testimony and documents on 21 November 2011, rather than 14 November 2011;
5. The Claimant and Respondent will notify each other of the name(s) of the witness(es) they wish to cross-examine on 28 November 2011, rather than 21 November 2011;
6. The rest of the schedule, as set forth in the 23 November 2011 Minutes of the First Session of the Tribunal, and SCB’s letter of 8 December 2011, will remain unchanged.
