JOINT STATUS REPORT

The Parties—Petitioner Deutsche Telekom AG (“DT”), by and through its counsel Hughes Hubbard & Reed LLP, and Respondent Republic of India (“Respondent” or “India”), by and through its counsel White & Case LLP—respectfully submit this joint status report further to the Court’s Minute Order dated July 25, 2022, which stayed the current proceedings pending the resolution of the revision proceedings in Switzerland and stated:

It is further **ORDERED** that the parties shall file a joint status report no later than 9/25/2022, and every sixty days thereafter, apprising the Court of the status of the ongoing revision proceedings in Switzerland.

Minute Order dated July 25, 2022.

The current proceedings remain stayed. The parties have conferred and jointly provide the following summary of the status of the revision proceedings in Switzerland.

The Swiss revision proceedings were concluded on March 8, 2023, pursuant to the decision of the Swiss Federal Tribunal (ECF 28-1). On April 13, 2023, DT filed a Notice of Foreign Judicial Decisions attaching the Swiss decision and additionally noting several recent decisions, including *Blasket Renewable Investments, LLC v. Kingdom of Spain*, No. 1:21-cv-03249, 2023 WL 2682013

(D.D.C. Mar. 29, 2023). India filed its Response on May 2, 2023. On April 14, 2023, this Court issued a Minute Order requiring the Parties to “file a joint status report by 4/28/2023 specifying each party’s position on how the action should now proceed.” As ordered, on April 28, 2023, the Parties filed a joint status report. ECF 29.

On May 24, 2023, “[u]pon consideration” of DT’s Notice of Foreign Judicial Decisions and India’s Response, as well as the Parties’ Joint Status Report, the Court ordered that the parties submit supplemental briefing to “address pertinent legal developments since briefing on respondent’s motion to dismiss was completed” and “whether it makes sense to defer ruling on this case until the consolidated appeals” of *Blasket* and two related cases are resolved by the D.C. Circuit. The Parties completed their respective supplemental briefing on June 28, 2023.
